

**Registered born puppies in Holland in
2013: 231**

We will put the recommendation to exclude LPN 2 D/N affected dogs as a point of discussion on our next breeders-meeting in October and hope to vote about this during our next General Members meeting in April 2015. A lot of breeders already tested their dogs.

Since June all breeds are controlled by the Dutch Kennel Club at Parentage by DNA profiling. This means that also all foreign dogs used by a Dutch breeder must have a DNA profile

Our next clubmatch is on the 14th of June 2015.

In 2016 we will celebrate our 50th anniversary.

During our new born puppy day in November we give the owners (also not members) the opportunity to take blood samples for LPN 1 and 2. We take care for a veterinarian and send the samples to Bern. The people then only have the cost for Bern. Last year approx. 40 dogs were tested by taking blood samples on this day.
